Entries/Changes made after 9 pm Thursday will be charged \$5.00 late fee. Scratches made before Friday at 9:00 pm will receive full refund.

Owner and Exhibitor must be a PWHAT member in order for points to count for PWHAT year-end high-point awards.

The Year-end Overall High Point Versatility Awards will be based on total points accumulated in classes 1-20 at all Versatility shows for the year. (In case of a tie, horse that showed at most shows wins the award)

PWHAT and WHOA are in full agreement with the USDA Horse Protection Act. PWHAT, WHOA and Show Management reserve the right to refuse or deny any entry for any valid reason at our discretion. Pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated section 44-20-103, PWHAT shall not be responsible for any accident, injury, death, or property loss resulting from participation at PWHAT events.
